

## **BREAST PUMP INFORMATION**



There are two options to secure use of a breast pump once discharged from hospital – rental or purchase.

### **RENTALS:**

Rental is a great option if you wish to use a high quality hospital-grade electric pump. Rental outlets typically require a major credit card to secure the pump rental.

Typical rental prices:

Monthly rental	- \$75 - \$100
Daily rental	- \$4/day with 10-day minimum
Double kit	- \$45 - \$55

### **TO PURCHASE:**

Many local retailers (Walmart, Toys R Us, Sears, most pharmacies) carry manual and/or commercial grade electric pumps.
