

CARSEAT CLINICS

Car crashes are the number one cause of death for Canadian children. A properly-used child car seat or booster seat can significantly reduce the chance of a child being hurt or killed in a collision. By law, drivers are responsible for ensuring passengers under 16 years of age are properly secured using approved child restraint equipment.
