

Family Medicine Physicians – BGH & TMH

The Division of Family Medicine at Quinte Health's Care Belleville General Hospital (BGH) and Trenton Memorial Hospital (TMH) is seeking an additional family medicine hospitalist physician. This opportunity is for a full- or part-time physician, who will have a shared commitment with both BGH and TMH.

Responsibilities at BGH include: inpatient care on our medicine unit, rehab units, orphan newborn care, and call. We offer Allied Support in PT, OT, SLP, Discharge planning, Palliative care, Spiritual care, and an Integrated Stroke Unit.

Responsibilities at TMH include: inpatient care on our medicine unit, complex continuing care, and call obligations.

Physicians benefit from 24-hour support from internal medicine, intensive care, general surgery, orthopaedics, urology, pediatrics, anesthesia, obstetrics and gynaecology, psychiatry, otolaryngology, ophthalmology, and radiology.

Physicians at BGH have access to state of the art diagnostic equipment including ER Ultrasound, a 64 multi-slice CT scanner with a Picture Archiving and Communication System (PACS) and an MRI. Physicians at TMH enjoy shared access to the services at BGH and also have access to onsite state of the art diagnostic equipment and a multi-slice CT scanner.

Considering our proximity to Kingston, several physicians are affiliated with Queen's University as Assistant Professors and regularly participate in resident training.



Family Medicine Hospitalist opportunities can easily be combined with Emergency Medicine at both sites and there are also opportunities for surgical assisting and obstetrics.

There are existing opportunities for Family Medicine Clinics in both communities.

The City of Belleville and the City of Quinte West offer financial incentives to medical residents and new graduates for their education in return for five-years service in the community.

Quinte Health Care

Quinte Health Care has 1,800 staff members and 320 medical staff who provide a wide range of high quality health care services to a region of 160,000 residents. Care is provided through four hospitals – QHC Belleville General Hospital, QHC North Hastings Hospital, QHC Prince Edward County Memorial Hospital and QHC Trenton Memorial Hospitals – and includes four emergency departments, operating rooms at three sites, inpatient services (including acute medicine, intensive care, obstetrics, paediatrics, mental health, complex continuing care, rehabilitation and surgery), a rehabilitation day hospital, children's treatment centre, ambulatory care clinics, community mental health programs, and a range of diagnostic services.

The Quinte area is in south-eastern Ontario. Our hospitals are located in Belleville, Picton, Quinte West (includes Trenton and Brighton), and Bancroft. The area includes some of the most diverse and beautiful countryside in Ontario. From the lakes of Bancroft down to the wine country, picturesque towns, and Sandbanks beach of Prince Edward County, and through the more urban Belleville/Quinte West/Brighton corridor alongside Lake Ontario, almost every lifestyle interest can be found within the communities served by QHC. The region offers low cost of living, affordable homes, and excellent schools as well as quality local theatre, shopping and restaurants. Belleville and Quinte West are located along the highway 401 corridor, and Toronto, Ottawa, Montreal, and Kingston are all easy driving distance.
