County Festival of Trees –

This is a large annual event held the last weekend in November each year. Local sponsors donate items such as decorated Christmas trees, wreaths, etc. for Silent Auction. This is a very large event and entails the cooperation of many volunteers. The event also includes a Bake Sale, Luncheon, Second Time Around Shop Sale and a Bucket Draw in each building. A craft group gets together periodically to produce crafts to be sold at the event. Numerous volunteer options are available!
