

Psychiatrist

Quinte Health Care has a vacancy for one Psychiatrist (permanent, full-time).

Acute Care Psychiatric/Mental Health Services are provided at QHC Belleville General Hospital as a Schedule One facility under the Mental Health Act. The program includes inpatient, outpatient, transitional outpatient care, emergency services, consultations, and educational services to the community. In addition to the Schedule One services, our spectrum of care includes an Assertive Community Treatment Team, a Crisis Centre, and a Parent, Child, and Youth Clinic. Our Psychiatry team provides 24 hour call coverage.

Physicians can be involved in all or some aspects of our mental health program.

QHC Belleville General Hospital has 28 psychiatric/mental health beds. The department is attached to the Department of Psychiatry at Queen's University as an Academic Unit and provides training to residents and students.

Psychiatrists mainly work out of QHC Belleville General Hospital but there is opportunity for outreach programs at each of the four Quinte Health Care sites (also includes Trenton Memorial Hospital in Quinte West, Prince Edward County Memorial Hospital in Picton, and North Hastings Hospital in Bancroft).

Candidates will require Royal College certification along with an independent license with the CPSO. Experience in a team environment, and excellent communication skills are essential.

Compensation is fee for service with sessional support; salaried option available.

Quinte Health Care

Quinte Health Care has 1,800 staff members and 320 medical staff who provide a wide range of high quality health care services to a region of 160,000 residents. Care is provided through four hospitals – QHC Belleville General Hospital, QHC North Hastings



Hospital, QHC Prince Edward County Memorial Hospital and QHC Trenton Memorial Hospitals – and includes four emergency departments, operating rooms at three sites, inpatient services (including acute medicine, intensive care, obstetrics, paediatrics, mental health, complex continuing care, rehabilitation and surgery), a rehabilitation day hospital, children's treatment centre, ambulatory care clinics, community mental health programs, and a range of diagnostic services.

The Quinte area is in south-eastern Ontario. Our hospitals are located in Belleville, Picton, Quinte West (includes Trenton and Brighton), and Bancroft. The area includes some of the most diverse and beautiful countryside in Ontario. From the lakes of Bancroft down to the wine country, picturesque towns, and Sandbanks beach of Prince Edward County, and through the more urban Belleville/Quinte West/Brighton corridor alongside Lake Ontario, almost every lifestyle interest can be found within the communities served by QHC. The region offers low cost of living, affordable homes, and excellent schools as well as quality local theatre, shopping and restaurants. Belleville and Quinte West are located along the highway 401 corridor, and Toronto, Ottawa, Montreal, and Kingston are all easy driving distance.
