

# Locum - Pathology

**The Department of Laboratory Medicine is seeking a temporary locum, for a 0.5 FTE, in Pathology for 1 to 6 months**

Quinte Health Care (QHC) is recruiting for a temporary LOCUM POSITION, for at least a 0.5 FTE equivalent position, or approximately 9 days per month, for approximately 1 to 6 months in Pathology for its Department of Laboratory Medicine located at QHC-Belleville General Hospital. The successful candidate may commence this temporary position as early as **January 17, 2022**.

The preferred candidate will be required to have a fellowship in General Pathology or Anatomical Pathology, registration with the CPSO and CMPA coverage. The successful candidate will provide surgical/anatomical pathology coverage for surgical specimens, intraoperative consultations and weekend call coverage. Quinte Health Care has an excellent group of pathology assistants and histology technologists who perform the specimen grossing. In 2019 there were 13,258 surgical specimens. In 2020, there was a decrease to 11,187 surgical specimens due to Covid-19 restrictions. Cytology, bone marrows and autopsies are referred out.

QHC offers a large complement of anatomical pathology cases in a state of the art laboratory, built in 2014. The Department of Laboratory Medicine currently has an allotment of 3.5 Laboratory Medicine physicians. Quinte Health Care is a four hospital healthcare system and the Department of Laboratory Medicine, situated at the Belleville site, provides a comprehensive laboratory service supporting all four QHC hospitals and has a strong link with the Kingston Health Sciences Center (KHSC). The histology/pathology laboratory team is wonderful to work with, and exemplifies all of the QHC values.

QHC serves the region through four hospitals – Belleville General Hospital, North Hastings Hospital (Bancroft), Prince Edward County Memorial Hospital (Picton) and Trenton Memorial Hospital – and includes four emergency departments, operating rooms at three sites, inpatient services (including acute medicine, intensive care, obstetrics, pediatrics, mental health, complex continuing care, rehabilitation and surgery), a rehabilitation day hospital, children's treatment centre, ambulatory care clinics, community mental health programs, and a range of diagnostic services.
